He has (co-)authored numerous publications on modelling, testing, and model-based testing and standards including the first ETSI Standard on Model-Based Testing, initiated and (co-)chaired a number of the ETSI User Conferences, and technically coordinated a number of interoperability events for various technologies. Since 2010, he is serving as the chair of ETSI's Technical Committee Methods for Testing and Specification (TC MTS).
