UCAAT (User Conference on Advanced Automated Testing) is a privileged place for exchanging ideas and sharing experiences. The event is dedicated to all quality and testing professionals involved in IT Systems (developers, engineers, experts, project or quality managers), from all sectors of activities (Telecoms, Bank/Insurance, ESN, Transports, Software Publishing, Security, Public Services...).

The objective is to offer the international community the opportunity to have an annual update on standards and technologies, enabling companies to be more competitive.

The conference will showcase the latest innovations in test automation, and will address many issues such as the standardization of the Test Description Language (TDL), but also test automation in agile environments, Model Based Testing, or mobile applications.

Organized around three days, this event aims to introduce innovative approaches, methodologies, experience, best practices and tools, allowing today industrial and services networks to increase their productivity and ensure the quality of their software solutions.

UCAAT is organized by the Technical Committee "Methods for Testing and Specifications" (TC MTS) of the European Telecommunications Standards Institute (ETSI), with more than 800 member companies and organizations, drawn from 64 countries across five continents. ETSI produces globally-applicable standards for Information and Communication (ICT), including fixed, mobile, radio, converged, aeronautical, broadcast and internet technologies. ETSI is officially recognized by the European Union as the European Standards Organization.

This event echoes ETSI's mission to promote automated testing to the relevant main actors, decision makers and observers of the market on a national and global scale.

UCAAT is the successor to the international conference MTB UC (Model-Based Testing User Conference) held in 2011 in Germany and in 2012 in Estonia.
